### Important Guidelines

**Date of Examination:** 22 March to 25 March 2026

**Timings for Examinations:**

- Morning Slot: 10:30 AM – 12:00 PM
- Afternoon Slot: 03:00 PM – 04:30 PM

**Questions type:** MCQ (Multiple Choice-Based Questions)

**Language:** English.

**Duration:** 90 minutes

**All questions are compulsory.**

**Negative Marking:** NONE. This is designed to encourage you to attempt every question

### Before Commencement of the Test

1. Ensure you have a stable internet connection.
  2. Reboot your computer/laptop before starting to free memory resources.
  3. This is a webcam-enabled test.
  4. The webcam may be built-in or externally mounted.
  5. Ensure the webcam is working and turned on.
  6. Check that the webcam image is in focus and captures your face (neck upwards clearly visible).
  7. **Environment:** Find a quiet, well-lit room. The proctoring system monitors eye movement and noise.
  8. Poor webcam footage may lead to disqualification of your examination attempt.
  9. Uninstall any third-party webcam software before starting the test.
  10. Use an updated browser (Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Firefox). Enable pop-ups.
  11. Close all messaging apps (Skype, AIM, MSN, Google Talk, Yahoo Messenger, etc.) and email programs.
  12. Do not open any other browser during the test.
  13. Clear cache and cookies before starting.
  14. Maximize your browser window.
  15. Keep a valid ID ready (Voter ID / Aadhaar Card / Driving License) for verification.
  16. **Calculations:** Since the math/quant sections are kept "Easy," you will likely only need a rough sheet and a pen.
  17. Click "**Start the Exam**" only when you are fully ready.

### Do's & Don't During the Test

1. Do not minimize or resize the browser.
  2. Do not press Back or Refresh.
  3. Use the "**Submit**" button to submit (do not press Enter).
  4. Do not keep a mobile phone with you.
  5. Do not leave your seat during the examination.
  6. Sit in a private, isolated room with no one else present.
  7. Any violation will trigger warnings and may result in cancellation.
